June 22, 2018 - House on the Rock

On day three, you will explore some of the world's most unique collections including the world's largest carousel, a 200' sea creature, automated music machines and much, much more at the House on the Rock. During the 1940's, a man named Alex Jordan discovered a 60-foot chimney of rock in the beautiful Wyoming Valley. It was here he

decided to build a house on the sandstone formation called Deer Shelter Rock. Jordan built the house as a weekend retreat and never intended it to be a tourist attraction. However, people kept coming to see the architectural wonder they had heard about. Jordan eventually started asking for 50 cent donations. That was only the beginning. The 14-room house is the original structure of what is now a complex of many buildings, exhibits and garden displays.

After our time at House on the Rock, we'll enjoy a variety of dining options at Joe's Casino before arriving at the fantastic riverfront Grand Harbor Resort.

June 23, 2018 - A Salute to the American Farm

Day four takes us back into Illinois. You will savor lunch at The Machine Shed in Rockford. This restaurant, dedicated to the American Farmer, is known for its award winning food and stellar service.


Our journey home includes a tour of historic Nauvoo. The Sauk and Fox Native American Tribes came to the Mississippi Valley and began many permanent settlements near where Nauvoo is today.

The European explorers and army surveyors started Nauvoo's precursor towns (Venus & Commerce) in the 1820's and 1830's.

The Mormons gave Nauvoo its name and built a town that once rivaled Chicago until religious persecution led them to head out west. Pictured below is the Nauvoo temple opened in June, 2002. The exterior is a replica of the first temple that was abandoned by the Mormons in the summer of 1845. We'll see the outside of this impressive structure and many other historic sites.

Dinner will be on your own as we head back to Missouri at the end of our day with memories of our trip on the road to Wisconsin.

Gems of the Adirondacks & Lake Placid

Fall in love with northern New York - teeming with natural beauty from pristine lakes to magnificent parks. Cruise on the emerald green waters amongst the 1000 Islands as you enjoy lunch and a lively narration. Pass by magnificent summer homes of the rich and famous, tour historic Boldt Castle and enjoy a welcome dinner at Belhurst Castle! Visit Adirondack Park and see the "Camp" built by A.G. Vanderbilt, the richest man in the country.

On our first full day, we'll visit Seneca Falls. This charming town was settled in the 1790s and is set alongside the falls of the Seneca River, a mile long series of rapids. We will stop at the Women's Rights Statue. During the 1840's, the advent of manufacturing opened new possibilities for women and for the first time they could work outside the home.

Seneca Falls is thought to be the inspiration for the fictional town of Bedford Falls in the holiday classic film, "It's a Wonderful Life." You will get a glimpse of the steel trestle bridge where Jimmy Stewart as George and the angel Clarence had their fateful encounter. Our lunch plans include a cruise on Skaneatele Lake with water so pure the city of Syracuse uses it unfiltered.

Your trip will also include a tour of the Corning Museum of Glass. From the glass portrait of an ancient Egyptian pharaoh to contemporary sculptures, it's an eye opening exhibit. To cap of your visit, enjoy a "Make Your Own Glass" project.



No trip to this part of the country would be complete without a cruise through the enchanting channels of the Thousand Islands. Learn about the region's rich history and savor the spectacular scenery and magnificent island homes. Your cruise includes a delectable luncheon buffet on board the triple deck vessel. You'll stop at Boldt Castle and hear the story of the 300 workers who fashioned the six story, 120 room castle. Construction began in 1900, then tragedy struck and work was halted, finally being completed nearly 80 years later.

You'll love visiting the Adirondack Museum in Blue Mountain Lake. This vast campus features displays in 22 modern galleries and historic buildings...telling the unique story of the Adirondacks and its people. From the one room schoolhouse built in 1907 to the Whiteface Fire Tower, you'll learn about Adirondack Park, the largest park in the continental US. In Raquette Lake, visit Great Camp Sagamore, the wilderness estate of the Vanderbilt family from 1901 to 1954.

And finally, the PC Bees will relive Olympic history in Lake Placid, New York. This was the home of the 1932 and 1980 Winter Olympics. Drive past both Mirror Lake and Lake Placid during your guided tour. Ride the chair lift and elevator to the sky deck atop the 26-story ski jump tower with spectacular views of the surrounding peaks. Visit the 1932 Olympic Area as well as the 1980 Arena (site of the US Ice Hockey Team's historic victory of the Soviet Union).

With everything from antique stores to bakeries, wine shops to art galleries, you are sure to find a souvenir of Lake Placid to take home after this wonderful trip.

Experience the Panama Canal on the Norwegian Star

JANUARY 3RD - JANUARY 18TH, 2019 • \$3,198/person

Join us as we experience an engineering marvel! The Panama Canal should be on everyone's list of must-see places. It'll surely be the highlight of this 16 day cruise/tour that includes five other countries as you cruise from Los Angeles and into Miami. Experience the thrill of your ship being raised and lowered 85 feet by man-made locks as you marvel at the enormity of this stunning feat of engineering. Today, it takes 8-10 hours to transit the canal passing through steel lock gates that are 6 feet thick and 60 feet tall. The original 40 pairs of gates, built in Pennsylvania, are still in use after more than 100 years. This engineering marvel is truly one that will be fascinating for everyone to experience!

Your ship enters the Panama Canal this morning for a full daytime transit of the canal. Construction on the 48 mile canal that connects the Atlantic and Pacific began in 1881

and was completed 33 years later in 1914. Named as one of the seven wonders of the modern world, nearly 15,000 ships per year travel through the canal. Pass through a series of locks that are flooded and emptied to raise and lower the Star as it makes its way from through the Canal. After a day in the canal, you'll be in the Atlantic Ocean!

January 15, 2019 - Cartagena, Colombia

You'll dock in Cartagena, Colombia, at 10:00 am. This city is one of the most historic cities in the Western Hemisphere. You might choose to explore the old city and see Simon Bolivar Square, Plaza de La Aduana and wander the narrow streets with their restored buildings, cafes and shops. Stop at a local museum or stroll along Las Murallas (the walls surrounding the city).

January 16 and 17, 2019 - At Sea


