October 22, 2019 - Leaving on a Jet Plane

We board our flight today and travel to Europe!

October 23, 2019 - Prague, Czech Republic

You will arrive in Prague today and be assisted with your transfer to your hotel. The balance of the day will be at your leisure to explore this beautiful city! Dinner is on your own in one of the area's wonderful local restaurants.

October 24, 2019 - Explore Prague

Today is yours to explore the Prague you want to see! From the thousand-year-old Hradcany Castle to beautiful St. Vitus Cathedral, you'll find getting around easy and the sights a delight! Don't miss iconic Charles Bridge where King Charles IV personally laid the first foundation stone in 1357! And be sure to see Old Town Hall with its spectacular astronomical clock installed in 1410 and running ever since. As you stroll along the banks of the Vltava River, you'll find plenty of quaint shops with local hand-crafts and delightful restaurants. As you explore Prague this evening, you'll notice the unique system used to illuminate monuments. It starts with the oldest monument to the youngest starting at dusk and completing just before midnight!

October 25, 2019 – Prague to Vilshofen, Germany

You'll check out of your Prague hotel this morning and travel through the beautiful Bavarian countryside bound for the charming 1,200-year-old town of Vilshofen. On arrival in Vilshofen, you'll board your luxurious ship, the AmaSonata to begin your Danube River cruise! Later this afternoon, join your fellow passengers at a private "Oktoberfest" celebration in Vilshofen, with traditional beers and Bavarian folk music and dancing. Return to the ship for a festive Welcome Dinner.

October 26, 2019 – Vilshofen to Passau, Germany

Explore Vilshofen's beautiful old town on your own before cruising to Passau. On arrival this afternoon, you will enjoy a walking tour of this 2,000-year-old city, noted for its Italian Baroque architecture, cobblestoned streets, and St. Stephan's Cathedral, home to one of the world's largest pipe organs.

October 27, 2019 – Linz to Gmunden, Austria

The AmaSonata arrives in Linz this morning for a guided walking tour of Austria's second largest city known for its vibrant art and music scene. Then, choose from three other excursions. The first is visit to the Austrian Lake District, the scenic Salzkammergut region. The second option is an excursion to the Czech town of Cesky Krumlov, a wonderfully preserved town nestled in the hills just over the Austrian-Czech border. The third choice is an excursion to Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, where you will take a walking tour of the historic center made famous by the "Sound of Music."

October 28, 2019 – Melk to Krems, Austria

You'll enjoy a scenic cruise through the narrow Strudengau this morning en route to Melk. On arrival, a guided tour will take you to Melk's magnificent Benedictine Abbey, one of Europe's



largest Baroque monasteries and the inspiration for the novel *The Name of the Rose*. You'll re-board the AmaSonata and continue cruising through the beautiful Wachau Valley to Krems where you will take a motor coach ride to Dürnstein. On your walking tour of this picturesque old town, see the magnificent blue façade of the local abbey church and the ruins of a castle where Richard the Lionheart was once imprisoned. Tonight, after dinner on board, enjoy a wine tasting at a local winery.

October 29, 2019 – Vienna, Austria

This morning you wake up in Vienna, the city of music! After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of Vienna, where you will see the famous Opera House, the Ringstrasse, and St. Stephen's Cathedral. The afternoon is free to stroll through the historic city center and enjoy this city of Mozart, Beethoven, Strauss and Brahms! The Viennese love Gemütlichkeit (relaxation) so you might just choose to indulge in a Sacher Torte and a Brauner (espresso with milk) as you explore! The AmaSonata remains moored in Vienna overnight for those who might want to enjoy an evening stroll along the Danube!

October 30, 2019 – Bratislava, Slovakia

Enjoy a scenic morning cruise to Bratislava where you will set out on a walking tour that includes the Old Town Hall, Mirbach Palace and St. Martin's Cathedral. With one of the smallest historical centers, the charm of Bratislava is undeniable with cobblestoned streets, pedestrian plazas and pastel 18th-century rococo buildings. As an alternative, you might want to take a "Communist" tour that includes such architectural landmarks as the Radio Building, Liberty Square and Soviet War Memorial. Prior to the fall of communism in 1989, Slovakia and the Czech Republic formed the former Czechoslovakia and you'll hear about its history. After your tours, you'll have the remainder of your day free to enjoy Bratislava on your own.

October 31, 2019 – Budapest, Hungary

This morning, your sightseeing tour takes you to the historic Buda Castle, which offers a splendid view of the river and the twin cities of Buda and Pest. Your tour also features the Fisherman's Bastion, Royal Palace, St. Stephen's Basilica, and Heroes' Square. After dinner, the ship will sail a special "Illuminations Cruise" past the beautifully illuminated river front of Budapest.

April 28, 2019 – Flying Planes and Black Pelicans

This morning, we'll depart to the Norfolk Botanical Gardens. Your tram ride around the 155-acre garden takes you to the Colonial Herb Garden, Presidential Garden, and more. Located in the heart of the Outer Banks, it was a flight that made Wilbur and Orville a household name and ushered in the era of airplane travel.

April 29, 2019 – Lighthouse and Elizabethan Gardens

As you head for Fort Raleigh, you'll stop at historic Bodie Island Lighthouse. The current lighthouse, completed in 1872, remains operational and stands an impressive 156 feet! After lunch, we'll tour the Elizabethan Gardens, established as a permanent memorial to Sir Walter Raleigh's lost colonists. memory forever. Next, you're off to lovely Lake Louise the setting for Chateau Lake Louise. This splendid chalet in surrounded by glistening glaciers, remote ice fields, snow-capped peaks, and crystal clear lakes and you'll have time on your own to enjoy the views. Then, depart for a cruise on Lake Minnewanka in the heart of the Canadian Rockies. Today, you also visit the birthplace of Canada's national parks, the Cave and Basin Historic Site. 



RECIPE

Salted Caramel Cookies

After serving these cookies at a recent PC Bees event, we had a request to share the recipe. These cookies are easy to make and have the buttery goodness of caramel.

Ingredients

- 1 cup butter softened
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon sea salt
- 3/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 36 caramels cut into eights

Preheat oven to 350° F. Line rimmed baking sheet with baking mat or parchment paper.

In a large bowl with an electric mixer, cream together butter and sugars until light and creamy, about 3 minutes. Add in eggs one at a time, mixing until completely incorporated. Add in vanilla.

In a separate bowl, whisk together flour, salt and baking soda. Slowly incorporate the flour mixture into the butter and sugar mixture until well-combined.

Stir in caramel. Scoop 1 tablespoon of cookie dough and drop onto prepared baking pan. Bake



for 10-12 minutes, or until the cookies are lightly golden brown. Cool and enjoy!
